Coach Dick Acres 4-A Division City Champions (77-69 over Banning) finished the '82 season 26-2 with both losses coming at the hands of arch-rival Banning. In winning the state's first basketball title, Carson had to get over Banning (a wild card team) in the Southern California Regional Championships (88-79) and then defeat the Northern California Division I champion, Washington of San Francisco, 54-53.

Although Eldridge Hudson was not named MVP in the Marine League (Gilbert Wilburn was selected from league champion Banning) he was a unanimous pick by the Foundation board for city Player of the Year honors. Hudson, after averaging 20.2 points per game in regular season play, averaged 25.1 points in seven city and state playoff games. He averaged 26.5 points in four city playoff games, and had 25 points and 25 rebounds in the title game. In the Southern California Reginnal finals against Banning Hudson had 28 points, 13 rebounds and seven assists.

In Carson's run for the 4-A crown the Colts clobbered Hamilton (80-57), San Fernando (71-62), and Crenshaw (70-53) before belting Banning. Banning's Pilots finished the year 24-4.


