LONG BEACH POLY STAR, CHRIS SANDLE, WINS MVP HONORS IN 4-A BASKETBALL OVER TOP-RATED TALENT

FOR RELEASE: FRIDAY, APRIL 6, am's ... and after ... ***PLEASE HONOR RELEASE DATE!!!

NO LESS THAN FOUR PLAYERS WERE NOMINATED FOR 4-A DIVISION PLAYER OF THE YEAR HONORS, BUT WHEN THE VOTE WAS TAKEN LONG BEACH POLY'S CHRIS SANDLE RECEIVED NEAR-UNANIMOUS SUPPORT FOR TOP-PLAYER RECOGNITION.....AS MEMBERS OF FIRST INTERSTATE BANK ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS MADE ITS ANNUAL HARCOURT SELECTIONS. SANDLE NOT ONLY LED THE JACKRABBITS TO THE 4-A SOUTHERN SECTION CHAMPIONSHIP (45-44 OVER MATER DEI), BUT ALSO TO THE CALIFORNIA STATE CROWN OVER ST. IGNATIUS OF SAN FRANCISCO, 65-45.

Other MVP nominees were Mater Dei's Tom Lewis and last year's 4-A MVP Matt Beeuwsaert, also of Mater Dei and Glendale Hoover guard Joe Hillman, who averaged 41.3 points over 26 games...3rd all-time southland performance behind Greg Goorjian (43.4 in '78) and Leon Wood (42.0 in '79)

Poly pulverized most of its opponents during its state championship season. The Jackrabbits defeated Culver City (63-42), Glendale (46-32), Redlands (71-52), Verbum Dei (51-40) and Mater Dei for the 4-A title. Poly then dispatched Foothill of Bakersfield (49-41), Crenshaw (58-54) and St. Ignatius for the California State Championship in Division I play.

K ELVIN BUTLER, NORTH RIVERSIDE'S 6-5, 230-POUND SENIOR CENTER WHO LED COACH MIKE BARBEE'S HUSKIES TO THE SOUTHERN SECTION, C.I.F. 3-A DIVISION BASKETBALL TITLE (OVER ESTANCIA, 63-53), HAS BEEN NAMED SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA'S 3-A PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF BASKETBALL. THE VOTE WAS UNANIMOUS.

IT IS ABSOLUTELY NO ONE'S SURPRISE, CRENSHAW HIGH'S FABULOUS ALL-AROUND HARD COURT PERFORMER JOHN WILLIAMS WAS AGAIN UNANIMOUSLY NAMED LOS ANGELES CITY 4-A DIVISION BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR, AS THE 47TH ANNUAL L.A. CITY ALL-STAR TEAMS WERE SELECTED BY FIRST INTERSTATE BANK ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S ALL-LOS ANGELES CITY BOARD OF ATHLETICS. EUGENE JACKSON, WHO LEAD RESEDA HIGH'S REGENTS TO THE 3-A DIVISION CITY TITLE, WAS ALSO A UNANIMOUS MVP CHOICE.
