#### **CHEERLEADERS & BAND**

Pep squads and pep bands of no more than 12 members will be admitted free of charge through the spectator entrance and must be in full uniform and/or carrying an instrument and accompanied by an adult supervisor. Pep squad members must arrive and enter the facility together. If pep squad members are arriving separately, we ask that you have them wait outside the venue until all members are present before entering.

#### **NOISEMAKERS PROHIBITED**

No noisemakers (horns, bells, victory bells, thunder sticks, sirens, chimes, cow bells, wooden blocks, musical instruments other than those in the band etc.) will be permitted inside the gym at any CIF Southern Section volleyball game.

The improper use of any of the above listed devices or any other artificial noisemaker by supporters of a team would subject that team to possible forfeiture of the contest. The use of music is <u>not</u> allowed by either team during pre-game. Any music played will be controlled by the PA announcer.

#### **BODY PAINT**

Face Painting is acceptable from the neck up only and shall not include any inappropriate letter and symbols. Assigned school staff shall monitor their cheering sections with regards to face painting. Students/Spectators with body paint any place other than their face will be asked to leave the facility.

#### **BANNERS AND POSTERS**

Posters and banners are an excellent way of creating good sportsmanship between competing schools. Only those posters and banners exhibiting this concept will be permitted. If you choose to place signs and banners you may only use blue painter's tape to attach to the walls or bleachers. Your school will also be responsible for the removal of these signs once your contest is complete.

#### COOLERS/FOOD/DRINKS

NO <u>HYDROFLASKS</u>, <u>OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINKS</u>, <u>ICE CHESTS</u>, OR <u>COOLERS</u> WILL BE ALLOWED INTO ANY CHAMPIONSHIP FACILITIES. A snack bar WILL be available. <mark>Only sealed, unopened water bottles are allowed into the gym.</mark>

#### PETS

No pets will be allowed inside the gym unless they are documented service animals.

#### **CHEERING SECTION**

Fan/Student cheering sections are encouraged to cheer and support their own team and should display proper sportsmanship with respect to the opposing team and the game officials. following guidelines and failure to do so may lead to removal from the contest and or/forfeiture of the contest.

The walk-way areas between the front row of the bleachers and the safety rail must remain clear. All spectators must be in the stands and clear of the railing.

#### PARKING

#### WARNING!

A Permit does not guarantee a parking space. The Cerritos College parking permit entitles a vehicle to park on the campus when space is available. During peak class periods, all lots may be full.

- Parking permits are only available online
- · Signs displaying the website to purchase parking permits are located in every parking lot and throughout the campus
- Permits must be valid for the current semester
- · Student permits are not valid in visitor or staff parking lots
- · Daily/Event permits can also be purchased through the online website
- · Parking permits are required every day, including weekends, from 7:00 AM to 11:00 PM
- · No overnight parking allowed unless approved by Cerritos College PD (special permit required)

Cerritos College Police Officers patrol the parking lots every day and night. However, persons parking on district property do so at their own risk. Cerritos College does not assume any responsibility for loss or damage to vehicles or their contents while parked anywhere on District property.

#### **Cross Streets:**

Cerritos College is located at the corner of Alondra Blvd and Studebaker Road in the City of Norwalk. The Administration Building faces North on Alondra Blvd.

#### From Downtown Los Angeles:

Take I-5 South to I-605 South, exit I-605 at Alondra Blvd, turn left on Alondra Blvd, take Alondra Blvd East. The college will be on the right just past Studebaker Road.

#### From South Bay Area:

Take I-105 East to I-605 South, exit I-605 at Alondra Blvd, turn left on Alondra Blvd, take Alondra Blvd East.

#### From Orange County:

Take I-405 North to I-605 North, exit I-605 at Alondra Blvd, turn right on Alondra Blvd, take Alondra Blvd East.

#### **From Riverside:**

Take I-91 West to I-605 South, exit at Alondra Blvd, turn right on Alondra Blvd, take Alondra Blvd East.
